1 ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The Organizing Authority will be Royal Freshwater Bay Yacht Club (Inc).

2 Rules

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 2.2 The IRC Rules 2010, parts A, B, and C shall apply where applicable.

3 ADVERTISING

The event will be classified as Category C in accordance with ISAF Advertising Code, Regulation 20.

4 ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY AND EVENT CATEGORY

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all yachts holding a current IRC Rating Certificate Card.
- 4.2 If by the closing date, less than 6 entries are received, the OA may change the eligibility requirements or cancel. Boats affected will have the option of confirming their entry under the new eligibility requirements, for no additional fee, or having their entry fee refunded.
- 4.3 Entries including payment shall be lodged at RFBYC reception, faxed to 9385 1483 or email to offshore@rbyc.asn.au by 23 August 2010.

5 ENTRY FEES

Entry fee is \$50.00 per boat.

8 REGATTA VENUE

Royal Freshwater Bay Yacht Club Inc, Keane's Point, Peppermint Grove

9 RACING AREA

The racing area will be on the waters of Melville Water.

10 COURSES

Courses will be Windward/Leeward. A diagram of the course area and marks will be included in the Sailing Instructions.

11 HANDICAPS & SCORING

11.1 Handicaps

IRC Ratings – current certificates to be lodged with entry form.

11.2 The Low Point scoring system of the RRS Appendix A will apply.

Six races are scheduled. Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

12 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

12.1 All Boats shall have a VHF Radio on board.

12.2 Except in an emergency a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

13 PRIZES

13.1 Prizes will be awarded for first three places on corrected time in each race. In addition, prizes will be awarded to the overall point score winners and two place getters in the IRC Series.

13.2 Results for each day's racing will be presented as soon as practicable after the race. Prizes for the overall points score in each class will be presented immediately following the last race on 26 March 2011 at Royal Freshwater Bay Yacht Club.

14 INSURANCE

Boats shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10,000,000 per event or equivalent.

15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk, See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
